A certified Water Well Contractor with over 18 years of experience, our staff includes several Professional Geologists, licensed in Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Mississippi and Tennessee. Action Environmental is capable of acquiring all required permits needed for your project including well construction, abandonment and general construction.

The 3230DT is the newest and one of the most powerful percussion units that Geoprobe® offers. Action Environmental operates a Chem Grout CG550 and Geoprobe® GS-1000. These grout pumps are capable of delivering cement grout at high pressure for bottom-up placement of grout. Abandonment can be provided for wells up to 12" diameter, and to depths greater than 500 feet.

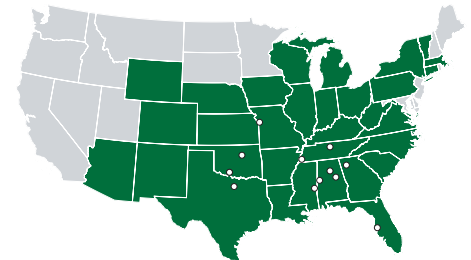
